



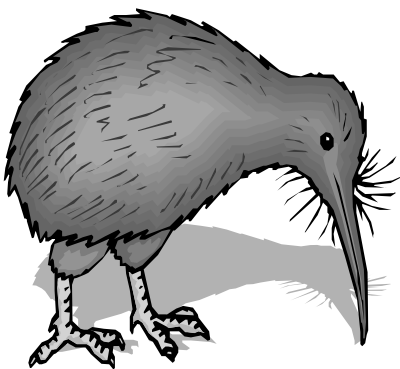

Astelia.	10	1.5m	Silver flax-like foliage.
Cabbage Tree.	10	20m	Very hardy. Suits Wet or Dry
Dianella	6	0.5m	Has blue berries.
Flax.	30	3m	Good shelter
Hebe.	10	1.5m	Flowering shrub.
Kahikatea.	10	60m	Tall tree. Likes moist conditions.
Karaka.	20	15m	Shiny dark green foliage
Kauri.	15	60m	Giant of the forest
Kawaka	20	25m	Grows well on dry ridges
Kawhitikaro	10	1m	Likes shade.
Kohekohe	20	13m	Handsome tree. Glossy leaves.
Korokia (A)	30	3m	Full sun shrub.OK for hedging
Korokia (B)	10	3m	Full sun shrub.OK for hedging
Kowhai	20	10m	Beautiful flowers.Grows most places.
Lacebark.	20	10m	Fast growing small tree.
Mairehau	10	3m	Flowering small tree.
Matai	7	25m	Large forest tree
Miro	20	25m	Attractive foliage
Pigeonwood.	10	12m	Great for birds. Tolerates wind
Pittosporum	3	9m	Good in mixed shelter
Puka.	15	8m	As above.
Puriri.	15	20m	Majestic. Well suited Waimate North
Rengarenga.	20	0.5m	NZ rock lily. Looks good in mass.
Rewarewa.	3	30m	Big tree. Handles dry conditions
Rimu	20	25m	Attractive, slow growing, graceful
Taraire	10	20m	Grows well locally. Berries for birds
Tawapou.	4	15m	Handles dry conditions
Toru	5	12m	Small branching tree.
